The Journal covers themes that from the beginning have represented the main research fields of the Institution: history and its auxiliary sciences, archeology, art, the history of law and economics, ethnography, Istriot and Venetian dialectology, the linguistics and culture of Istria, Rijeka, Kvarner, Dalmatia and neighboring regions, from prehistoric times to the First World War. The main purpose of the journal was and still is to offer an objective and qualified testimony of the history and culture of the autochthonous Italian community in the historical, social, political, and cultural context of the eastern Adriatic which has always been a contact area between various cultures and historiographies.
